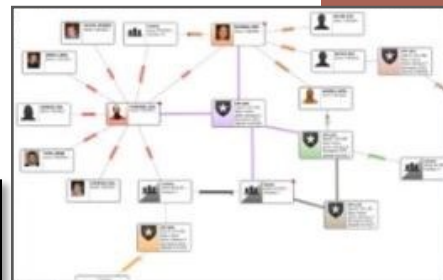

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BULLETINS/NEWSLETTER

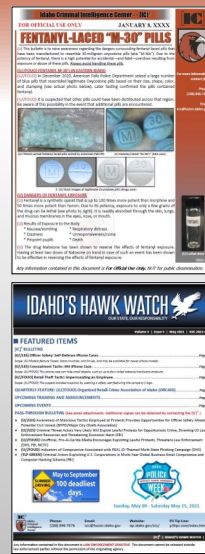
[IC]² creates tactical and strategic products to help keep Law Enforcement informed on current topics impacting our State.

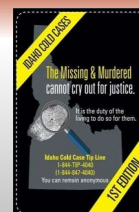
FUSION LIAISON OFFICER (FLO) PROGRAM

FLO's are representatives from their respective agencies that receive training on recognition of patterns indicating terrorism or major crimes. They act as:

- * Information Collectors: passing crime trend information or suspicious activity to the [IC]² for analysis.
- * Information Disseminators: passing [IC]² information to the FLO's agency and command staff, as appropriate.
- * Subject Matter Experts (SME): the [IC]² acts as an informational hub to help agencies connect with SMEs from other agencies.
- * Agency Crisis Contacts: in the event of a crisis incident, the FLO would 1) act as the first point of contact for the [IC]²; or 2) provide the [IC]² with an administrative contact for RFI's.
